

## Combermere Abbey Farm

Where energy generation and natural habitats can coexist

Our task was to build a 14MW solar farm in Combermere Abbey, Whitchurch, while also taking into account the needs of the environment in which we were building and habitats that could be disrupted. This 13.97MW installation was fitted using 47,520 305w modules connected to 198 inverters. The farm is set over two fields with approximately equal power being generated in each.

Because there is protected wildlife living within the site location, we had to plan our construction periods around this, which meant that most of the installation happened between November and February. The final result – renewable energy generation coexisting alongside the fields’ natural inhabitants – a solution that’s better all round.
